

## Scrapbooks Forever July Project of the Month

### Lip Balm Holder By Sizzix

Summer is in full swing! Here is a sweet, fast little project that you can use as a gift box for the very useful staple, lip balm. A gift for all seasons!



All you need to make this handy-dandy little holder is the Sizzix Lip Balm Holder die, your die-cutting machine, some favorite paper (double or single sided or solid card stocks will work great), and some glue, Scor-tape, or a tape runner. You will also need some ribbon or twine for tying the top of the holder in place.



Start by trimming your paper to fit the size of your die and your machine. There are two parts to the holder, an outer part and a smaller inner part with all the cuts that will fold and pop-out to hold your lip balm in place. After you get both of these pieces cut out, you can assemble them with your choice of adhesive.

Keep in mind, if you are using a double-sided card stock, you can choose a couple different ways to put these together for different complimentary effects.



After you have assembled the base of the holder, it is ready of you to slide in your lip balm gift through the strip that pops up in the center and secure the lip balm with the tabs that pop up at each end of this inner piece. The last step of this assembly is to string a ribbon or twine through the slots at the top edge of the holder.



In addition to the base pieces, this die by Sizzix also includes a number of dies for adding decoration. There is a piece for a label, the word “Smile” in a cute font, a circle, small flower pieces and a flower center, a flourish, a branch, and an owl base and detail dies. Some of these can be seen in the photo at the top of this project.
