
December 2017 Project of the Month



Paper Smooches Cat/Dog Card Die set:


A variety of animals can be made by mixing and matching these dies.

My favorite, the cat, is shown.



Die cut all the pieces to the face of the animal you wish to make.

Arrange them on a 4 %" x 5 %" piece of cardstock, but DO NOT GLUE them yet.







Place the die as shown to get your cutting position for the die that cuts the top of the head. This way you have a chance to move all the pieces, angle the head and get different expressions just right. Once satisfied, you can glue the pieces, then die cut.

OR

OPTION 2: my preference

Remove all face pieces, die cut the head

And then:

Glue the face pieces in place using a Zig Two way Glue Pen.

If whiskers are too fussy, you may use a ruler and a marker to draw them instead.



Fold a white A2 size card that hinges at the top. Cut one inch off the bottom of the card front.

Make a 4 ¼" x 4 ¼" printed cardstock panel and attach to front of card, leaving 1/4" white at the bottom of the card front.



Glue your animal in place as shown.

Stamp messages from coordinating greeting stamp set and/or print from a computer.

Mat and glue in place as shown.

Wrap baker's twine around "neck" of animal. Use a little liquid glue to hold in place.
