

Striped frames and mats



Materials:

Pinkfresh Studio Dies: Diagonal Stripes Window and Fancy Diagonal Stripes (panel)

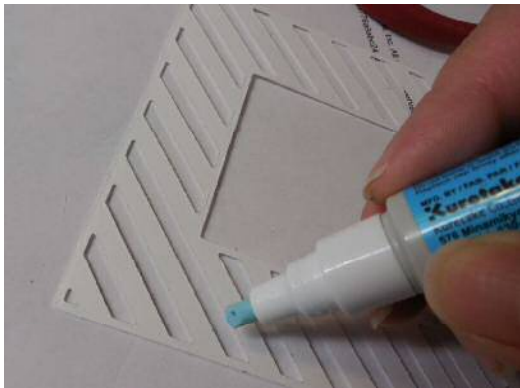
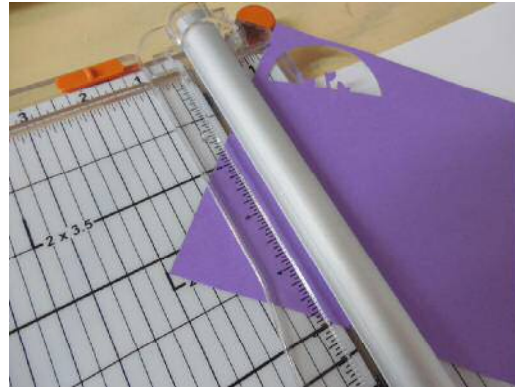
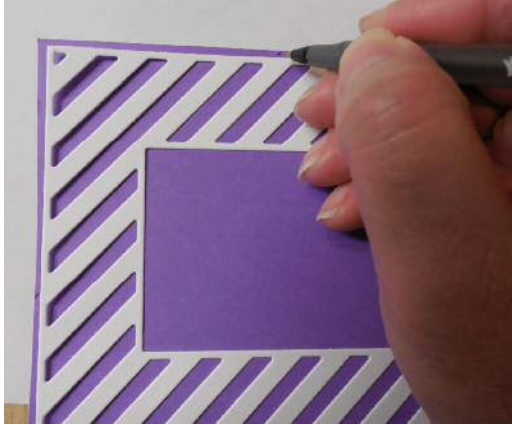
Assorted color cardstock-any weight, plus 100 lb. white cardstock

“Tye Dye” style scrapbook paper

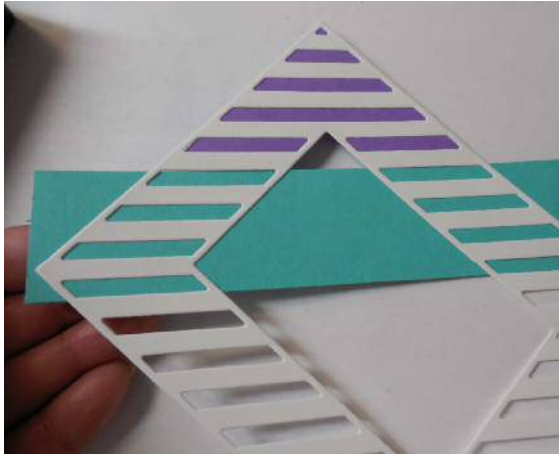
Two way Glue pen



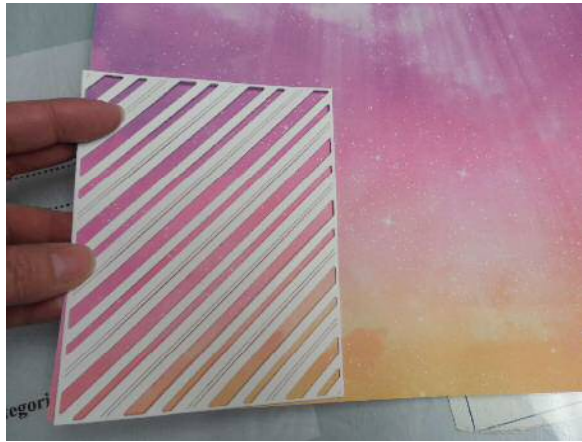
1) Die cut the Diagonal window die in 100 lb. white cardstock. The frame needs to be cut from heavy cardstock to handle being manipulated as you attach various colors to the back to create custom stripes.



- 2) Lay frame on cardstock and mark with a pen how many stripes you want in that color.
- 3) Use a paper slicer to cut off the piece you measured.
- 4) Put two way glue on the back of the striped sections.
- 5) Attach frame to the colored cardstock. Trim any that hangs over the edges or the opening.



- 6) Keep going in the same manner: measuring, gluing and trimming.
- 7) Change colors and number of stripes to create infinite combinations to match any project or holiday!



You can do the solid panel the same way as above, or cheat a little bit and use a multi-colored paper as shown. Also try just one color on either die. Look how nice just a solid red would look for Valentine's Day or Christmas.
